Coronavirus Prevention Measures

It is so good to see that the coronavirus rates are much lower locally and even though the rate is expected to rise with some of the restrictions being relaxed it is hoped that the rise will be limited and not as rapid as before. It is important that we continue with our measures to help reduce the risk of virus transmission. Thank-you for wearing masks when you come to the school and for maintaining the 2m distance. Due to the staggered start and end of the school day please remember to leave the area outside of school as soon as you have dropped off and collected your child / children to reduce congestion. Also please keep your child at home if they are feeling unwell.

Possible illness

As in the autumn term we are aware that some people do not show the three symptoms of coronavirus to start with: high temperature, continuous new cough and loss of taste / smell. Some can have a headache, aching muscles and joints or vomiting and/or diarrhoea. If your child has any of these symptoms please keep them at home and speak with us if you are unsure of the cause.
