Dear parents and carers,

Happy New Year to you all, we hope the new year has started well. As always it is a delight to see the children return to school ready for a new term.

As we start the new term, we have started new topics, which is always exciting.

The children in Silver Birch Class are studying World War Two, on Monday they came to school dressed as evacuees and brought in artefacts from the time. Mr Pitt and Mrs Wood also dressed up in clothes of the time and they all looked the part.



Some of the children had completed their own research over the weekend which they shared with the class. On Monday they are visiting Newhaven Fort to learn more about World War Two.





The topic in Holly Class is extreme weather and they have started this with looking at tornadoes and hurricanes. They have been looking at what happens in a tornado by creating a representation of them in water bottles filled with water, a tiny amount of washing up liquid and glitter. The glitter enabled the children to see what happens to objects in the high winds.



They are busy researching facts about tornadoes and hurricanes and their home learning is finding out about extreme weather happening in the world now.

Beech and Willow classes are using Carnival of the Animals by Camille Saint-Saens to start their topic on animals.

The children in Willow class have been reading animal stories, based on the Noah's Ark story. They have enjoyed setting up and playing in their Vet Role Play Corner. They have been estimating and counting to 10, to 20, and beyond and developing strategies for counting larger groups of objects accurately. They have been paying each other compliments and talked about how they made them feel.

Beech are researching animals for their non-fiction writing and looking at the habitats of animals. In maths they have been exploring shapes and will be looking at money next. Please give the children chance to look at money with you, especially the values of coins.
