PUPIL PREMIUM IMPACT REPORT 2015/16

What is the Pupil Premium Grant?

The Pupil Premium Grant was introduced in April 2011. It is allocated funding from the government for low income families who have been eligible for free schools meals during the last six years. It has subsequently been extended to children who have been previously looked after and those from service personnel families. The purpose of the funding is to close the gap in achievement of these children when compared to all children nationally.
