Contingency Management Plan and Risk Assessment

Attached with the newsletter is a summary of our Contingency Management Plan to deal with any cases – **please read this carefully** as there are changes to actions if there is a positive case in school. Our risk assessment will be sent once finalised.

Uniform and PE kits

Children are to wear their full uniform everyday and bring in PE kits to stay in school all week. Please enusre children are wearing plain white, black or grey socks.

Start and end of school times

All children are to arrive between 8.45 and 9am. KS1 will finish at 3pm, KS2 at 3.05pm.

Gates

We will continue to use both gates to start with. Willow and Beech classes using the top gate by the office and Holly and Silver Birch clasees to use the gate nearest to the church. If your child has a bike or a scooter either gate can be used to put it in the bike park.

Good hygiene and ventilation

Good handwashing and tissue hygiene and ventilation must continue and please encourage this outside of school also.



Playtimes, lunch and bubbles

We are so pleased that the children can now have play and lunchtime together and will no longer be kept in separate bubbles.

Assembly / worship

Whole school assemblies and worship will be held again in the hall along with some in church. Parents will be invited to the Friday Celebration Assembly after half term to allow the children to settle and get used to being altogther again. We will send home a photo if your child receives an oak leaf so you can celebrate their success.
