#### **Our Currciulum**

We have changed our topic approach to learning with each class focusing on a theme that promotes our vision characteristics and teaching the National Curriculum through the theme.

This term Willow, Beech and Silver Birch are exploring 'We Are Friends', focusing on being: able to embrace diversity and difference, kind and caring, and sociable. Holly are exploring 'We Are Acheivers,' focusing on being successful, physically and mentally healthy and knowledgeable. The teachers will send home more information about the subjects they are teaching this term soon.

We are continuing with promoting a growth mindset, using the Learning Pit and help children to self-regulate and understand differences through the Zones of Regulation – please see our website for more information.
