So far, we have raised £1,445 in donations from parents and local companies. The work will cost at least £5,000.

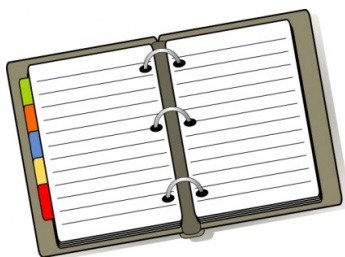
We would like to raise this on top of our usual fundraising, which is still essential.

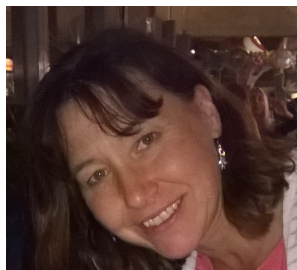
Thursday 9th March – Bags of Support clothing collection. Look out for the bags in book bags.
